

Club Bingo at Mingara

Club Bingo Sessions

Days: Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, Sundays

Times: Books on sale from 9.30am, calling starts at 10.30am.

Club Bingo operates on Public Holidays except Christmas Day or unless advised.

Games: 25 Full House Games
5 Minor Games

Prices: \$3 ½ Book
\$5 Full Book
\$10 2 x Full Books
\$15 4 x Full Books
\$20 8 x Full Books
\$1 Stylus for use on PET

Note a minimum of 2 book purchase required to use PET. Prices are per player.

Prizes: Full House Games Prize is \$25
Minor Game Prize is \$10

Prizes are added to members accounts as Mingara Reward Points. Non – members will be issued Mingara Vouchers. (Mingara Reward Points and Mingara Vouchers are not transferable for cash).

House Rules:

- A session is defined as a period of time in which bingo is participated.
- Before the start of play, Bingo Rules are explained to all players. If players are unsure of the rules, they need to alert the Bingo Caller to gain clarification before the start of the session or game.
- Sessions operate every Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Sunday.

- Full Bingo books are sold as 25 pages with 6 games per page, available as paper or electronic books.
- ½ books are also available and are sold as 25 pages of 3 games per page, available as paper version only.
- Where a discount is offered for the purchase of multiple books, these books cannot be split amongst multiple individual players.
- Any decision by the caller is considered final.
- In the event that a number is incorrectly called by the caller, the number called will stand. In the event that there is a winner on that game with an incorrectly called number and the majority of patrons are aware of the error the prize will be paid.
- The player can only claim a prize when their winning game includes the last number called.
- A number called is not considered final until the caller has repeated the number in sequence.
- Prizes are not redeemable for cash and cannot be exchanged.
- Full House Games Prize is \$25, Minor Game Prize is \$10.
- Employees, Contractors, Board of Directors and Community Advisory Members are eligible to participate in Bingo, unless they are working at the time of the session.
- Children under the age of 18 years are permitted to participate in Club Bingo only if they are under the direct supervision of a parent or guardian. Prizes will be awarded to the supervising Parent or Guardian.
- Prizes are added to members accounts as Mingara Reward Points. Non – members will be issued Mingara Vouchers. (Mingara Reward Points and Mingara Vouchers are not transferable or redeemable for cash).
- To claim a Full House prize players are required to;
 - Marked off a full individual game of 15 numbers as called by the bingo caller.
 - The player is responsible for alerting the caller to claim their prize.
 - The player can only claim their prize when their winning game includes the last number called.
 - The winning game and ticket will be verified by Club representatives before paid.
 - Where two or more winners occur for any game, the prize will be evenly split to the nearest Mingara Reward Point (rounded up to the nearest point if required). Where this cannot occur, the caller will conduct a game of chance to determine the winner. Each player will receive a random number and the highest number will claim the prize.
- To claim a Minor Game prize players are required to;
 - 5 Minor games will be conducted as part of Club Bingo Session.
 - These games will take place on the 5th / 10th / 15th / 20th and 25th Games.
 - The Minor Game format will be announced before the start of each minor game.
 - The player is responsible for alerting the caller to claim their prize.
 - After the Minor Game is played, the caller will confirm the winner/s and continue to call for a Full House Game and Prize.
 - The player can only claim their prize when their winning game includes the last number called.
 - The winning game and ticket will be verified by Club representatives before paid.
 - Where two or more winners occur for any game, the prize will be evenly split to the nearest Mingara Reward Point (rounded up to the nearest point if required). Where this cannot occur, the caller will conduct a game of chance to determine the winner. Each player will receive a random number and the highest number will claim the prize.
