

CASH HOUSIE RULES – AUGUST 2016 – Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service (WRHS)

1. Cost of playing books and tickets are displayed separately at this counter (including electronic devices).
2. Book and ticket prices will not be discounted for late customers (including electronic devices).
3. Players can purchase and play only 1 electronic device per person.
4. Players are not allowed to play more than 1 electronic device as a time, including playing for someone who is arriving later, or who has left the room i.e toilet, lunch or sick.
5. Players can purchase maximum 8 books and jackpot sheets per person – paper or electronic device.
6. Electronic device players must present receipt to purchase any additional jackpot sheets to ensure the maximum is not exceeded.
7. Players are responsible for their Housie books, tickets, dabbers and electronic devices and they will not be replaced if lost or stolen.
8. Players must wait until a number is called and repeated in full by the Caller before declaring they are a winner.
9. The number shown on the visual display screen is the legally correct number. If a number has been called incorrectly it must be corrected by the Caller and the number shown on screen will be declared correct.
10. Call out loud and put your hand up and keep it up if you are a winner. It is the player's responsibility to ensure the Caller knows you are a winner. Game is concluded when the Caller announces 'House pays one or more winners, game is now closed'. No further prize split will be allowed after this announcement.
11. Prizemoney is shared equally between the winners and is rounded to the nearest dollar.
12. More than one serial number of any type of book or ticket are allowed to be used during a session providing the different serial numbers are clearly stated by the Caller before commencement of each game.
13. A winning ticket is a one that has a completed full house (except for line games). You do not have to go out on the last number called.
14. Prizemoney will not be paid on games played on incorrect serial numbers. Players must check each ticket's serial number before playing each game.
15. Prizemoney will be calculated based on book & ticket sales at each session and shall not exceed 75% of gross takings at each session.
16. To win a Jackpot game you must have a completed full house within the number of calls stated by the Caller before the Jackpot game commences.
17. Players are not allowed to buy and play Jackpot sheets or Jackpot Books only. You must buy and play Ordinary Books or Book 1 & Book 2 in conjunction with Jackpot sheets and Jackpot Books. Jackpot sheets are optional. Prizemoney will NOT be paid to anyone playing Jackpot sheets or Jackpot Books only.
18. The Permit, Permit Conditions & financial statements are available at the selling counter in a folder or on display.
19. Any immediate family member who is related to any Housie staff, including Club staff, on duty representing the benefitting organisation (WRHS) must be publicly announced at the session. Their winning ticket must be checked by one independent player together with staff calling back.
20. Children are allowed to play Cash Housie in those Clubs that do allow children entry into the auditorium. Children must be accompanied by an adult & must be restrained & quiet during the session. Housie Staff have authority to request the removal of disruptive children & adults from the session.
21. If a child wins a game their prizemoney must be given to the accompanying adult.
22. Raffles are not permitted to be re-drawn if unclaimed at the session. The outstanding ticket number will be displayed at the session until it is claimed. Prizes must be claimed within 3 months before being offered again.
23. Where Club Bingo and Cash Housie is conducted these Housie Rules apply for Cash Housie. A half hour break between Club Bingo and Cash Housie is required by law.
24. Disputes concerning prizemoney and the conduct of the Housie session shall be directed to the WRHS Housie Staff in the first instance. If any player is not satisfied with their decision please contact Milena Hartnett, Housie Fundraising Manager on 1800 155 155 weekdays 9.30am – 5.30pm.
