



Terms & Conditions

- I understand that Links operates by a direct debit system, the amount will continue to be charged fortnightly unless I give Mingara notification to temporarily suspend or cancel my Learn to Swim or Squads with notice.
- I understand that there will be a charge of \$5.00 upon enrolment as an administration fee.
- I understand if my debit fails, I will be charged a failed debit fee.
- Learn to Swim and Squads must present their card to reception upon entry to their class.
- Learn to Swim and Squads are automatically re-enrolled every year.
- If direct debits consecutively fail Mingara reserves the right to remove the child from enrolled class.
- Learn to Swim and Squad cards can only be used to enter the aquatics facility during the specified lesson times only.
- I understand that there will be an upfront Pro-Rata payment that will need to be paid upon enrolment before the first swim lesson and before the first squad session.
- Debits are taken out on Fridays every fortnight.
- In the event I wish to cancel, a cancellation form must be completed. Forms are available at reception and cannot be accepted via fax or email. Cancellations require 30 days' notice for Learn to Swim and Squads.
- In the event of a price increase, Mingara will provide 30 days' notice in writing before the new prices will come into effect.
- I am entitled to 2 weeks holiday suspension time for Learn to Swim and 6 weeks for Squads, this must be applied for in advance and will not be back dated.
- I understand that Learn to Swim does not stop for the mid-year school holidays in April, July, and September. It only breaks for the Christmas/Summer period school holidays.
- If your class for Learn to Swim falls on a public holiday you will not be charged for this lesson as we do not hold classes on any public holidays throughout the year.
- If your child progresses through Learn to Swim into Squads you will be required to complete the necessary paperwork available at reception.
- Any changes to your bank details or contact details you will be required to complete a variation request form available at reception.
- I understand that Squads does not have a break and swims throughout the whole year except for public holidays.
- It is a condition of Mingara Aquatics Learn to Swim and Squad program that the responsible parent aged over 18 must be and remain members of Mingara Recreation Club Ltd.
- Learn to swim and squad swimmers aged over 13 must be and remain as a junior member of Mingara Recreation Club Ltd.
